St. Thomas University invites applications for an instructor to teach the following course in Fredericton

Semester 3 (MAY 13 – JUNE 24, 2025)

EDUC-5133. Shared Leadership (Tuesdays/Thursdays 4:00 - 6:50pm)

This course focuses on teacher leadership. It begins with an examination of traditional roles of the principal as a school leader. Students will then examine the concepts and practices of school improvement and the essential role of teacher leadership in this process. The cultural, social, and institutional barriers that prevent teachers from building leadership capacity in schools will be discussed and students will analyze reciprocal learning processes that build the authentic relationships required to develop sustainable, self-renewing schools. (Maximum enrolment: 30)

St. Thomas University is an undergraduate, liberal arts institution with a full-time enrolment of 1,600. Its students graduate with Bachelor of Arts, Applied Arts, Education, and Social Work degrees. The faculty members are distinguished teachers, researchers and scholars, and the university holds two Canada Research Chairs.

MEd, BEd, and NB teaching license (or equivalent) are required. Recent school-based K-12 classroom teaching or administrative experience within the last five years is preferred. Demonstrated ability to support teacher candidate learning in online and face-to-face modes is an asset. Candidates who provide evidence supporting their ability to foster a positive learning environment will be given preference. Each applicant is to submit a curriculum vitae, along with pertinent documentation (ex. teaching portfolio etc.) and arrange to have three letters of reference sent directly to Dr. Grant Williams, Director, School of Education, St. Thomas University, Fredericton, NB E3B 5G3.
