Packing

What you'll NEED

- Sheets, blankets, pillows
- Clothing hangers
- Government issued picture ID
- Personal toiletries: shower flip flops, towels, etc.
- Clothes and shoes for winter times
- Laundry hamper, non-HE laundry detergent and fabric softener

You MAY bring

- Small appliances (electric kettle/ coffee maker)
- Decorations (posters, pictures, rugs)
- Your own kitchen utensils
- Surge protectors/ power bar

You may NOT bring

- Open element appliances or cooking appliances (BBQ, air fryers, toasters, hot plates, electric grills, etc.)
- Large volume alcohol containers or items that promote unsafe alcohol consumption: drinking games, funnels, or any other drinking paraphernalia
- Candles, incense, potpurri burners, flammable liquids, etc.
- Halogen lamps
- Pets
- Explosive/firecrackers
- Illegal Drugs
- Subwoofers/ Amplifiers
- Weapons: knives, martial arts weapons, firearms, replica weapons, etc.
