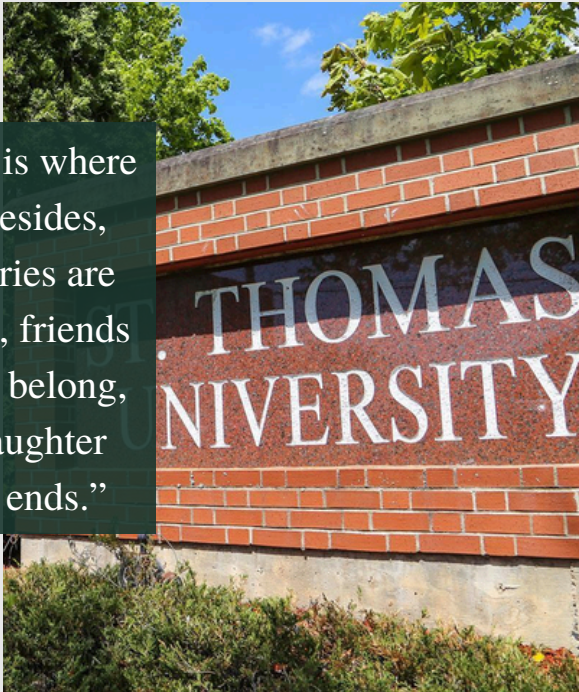

CONFIRM YOUR ROOM ASSIGNMENT

To confirm your room assignment, you must pay a **non-refundable \$300 confirmation fee**. This fee is due 10 business days after you selected your room assignment.

NOTE: If you have not selected your room, please note that you may be manually assigned. If you have been manually assigned, we will communicate your assignment via your STU email.

Residence Fees & Meal Plans Update

Our Board of Governors has approved the University's budgets for the coming academic year which includes residence fees and meal plans. Within the budget is a change to the meal plan structure. All residence students will now have a freedom meal plan allowing them to use the dining hall services as frequently as they wish. Your meal plan selection will automatically be updated in ERezLife.
